Sir,

Standing Committee at its meeting held on 23rd February, 2016 considered the above mentioned subject. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Standing Committee considered the inspection report of School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh and further, Committee is of the view that as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 University be granted recognition for the purpose of conferring the degree of law for imparting three year and five year law courses and also granted fresh approval of affiliation to School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh for running three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of one year i.e. for the academic years 2016-2017 subject to the following conditions :-

1. The college management is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules - 2008.
2. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.
5. To buy text books @ 10 in each subject and journals in terms of clause 15 in schedule III of the Legal Education Rules, 2008 as initial investment.
6. To comply and maintain the requirements of 'Core-Faculty' as per the provisions of Rule 17 of Schedule-III of the Legal Education Rules-2008.
7. The class routine in each stream, indicating the class hours should be prepared as per the Rule 18 of the Rules of Legal Education Rule, 2008 and submit a copy to the Bar Council of India for verification. The classes should commence from 10 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. with lunch/tea break of 30 minutes. The university should ensure that the classes are held regularly.

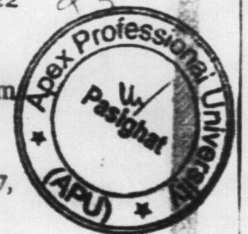

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report of School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh and further, Committee is of the view that as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 University be granted recognition for the purpose of conferring the degree of law for imparting three year and five year law courses and also be granted fresh approval of affiliation to School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh for running three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 subject to the following conditions :-

1. The college management is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules - 2008.
2. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.

Sir,

The Legal Education Committee of the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 27th April, 2019 considered the inspection report of School of Law and Juridical Sciences, Apex Professional University, Arunachal Pradesh submitted by the inspection team.

After consideration, Committee is of the view that **School of Law and Juridical Sciences, Apex Professional University, Arunachal Pradesh** be granted **temporary extension of approval of affiliation** for running **three year LLB and five year B. A. LL.B. integrated degree courses** with intake of **two sections of 60 students in each section in each course** for the academic years **2018-19 and 2019-2020**.

As per inspection report, except one or two, other faculty members are paid consolidated amount or paid Rs.500 per lecture for law subjects and similarly for social science subjects, they are paid consolidated amount, which is against the statutory rule. Under the statute, each core faculty member has to be paid Government/UGC Scale not a fixed amount.

The constituent unit of the University to do the same within three months and communicate to the Bar Council of India within the same period. In case, the compliance is not done, the Committee will consider whether to grant any further extension beyond the academic year 2019-2020.
